

Earning Credits for Pension

From and after January 1, 2007, you earn one Pension Credit for 1,440 hours of covered employment in a calendar year. If you work fewer than 1,440 hours in a calendar year beginning on or after January 1, 2007, you will earn a proportional Pension Credit for that calendar year under the following Pension Credit schedule:

Less than 288	None
288 to 431	.2
432 to 575	.3
576 to 719	.4
720 to 863	.5
864 to 1,007	.6
1,008 to 1,151	.7
1,152 to 1,295	.8
1,296 to 1,439	.9
1,440 or more	1.0
