may be used for reimbursement of Medicare Part B premiums. Reimbursement will

only be made upon the request of the member. The current plan requirement of

having a minimum of three months of premium banked at the coverage level and tier for which the member is enrolled before the Value Bank will reimburse medical

expenses, does not apply for reimbursement of Medicare Part B premiums.

2) All other provisions in the Plan shall continue in full force and effect.
